Review criteria

AREA	STANDARD	REJECT OR REVISE WHEN
Expertise	Author competence is clear.	Claims exceed expertise or evidence.
Evidence	Important claims are evidence-aware.	Material is motivational but unsupported.
Pedagogy	The learner knows what to do.	Slides or notes are uploaded without learning design.
Ethics	Privacy, fairness, and limits are considered.	Sensitive data or unsupported advice appears.
Design	Layout is readable and branded.	Material feels unpolished or inconsistent.

PII and sensitive data rules

- Do not publish student records, participant data, personal contact details, or admin documents.
- Replace real people, schools, organizations, and raw data with synthetic examples unless explicit permission exists.
- Remove source metadata and comments from public documents.
- Use source material for topic structure and expertise, not for copying protected content.
